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## FUTURE CLASSROOMS' LEADERSHIP

The Erasmus+ Workshop on Distance Learning and eLearning Platforms took place in North Macedonia from April 23 to April 28, 2023. The event aimed to provide educators and coordinators with practical insights into effective distance learning methodologies, the use of eLearning platforms, and multimedia creation tools. The workshop was organized in two cities, Skopje and Ohrid, offering a diverse range of activities and learning experiences.

**Day 1: Registration, Welcome & Introduction (Skopje):** The event commenced with registration and a warm welcome to all participants. Administrative remarks were shared, setting the tone for the workshop. An informative presentation about the faculty and the military academy provided context for the learning journey ahead. A tour of the classrooms and facilities followed, giving participants a comprehensive understanding of the learning environment.



## **Day 2: Methodology of Distance Learning and Teamwork Practices (Skopje)**

The second day focused on methodologies for effective distance learning and teamwork practices. Participants engaged in interactive workshops, sharing insights and best practices. A coffee break offered an opportunity for networking and informal discussions.

## **Day 3: Introduction to eLearning Platforms (Skopje)**

Workshop 2 delved into e-Learning platforms, particularly Moodle and other commonly used platforms. Participants gained practical experience navigating these platforms and exploring their functionalities. The day ended with a dissemination and evaluation status meeting among coordinators.

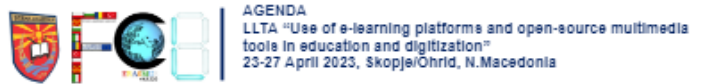


## Day 4: Multimedia Creation and Cultural Exploration (Ohrid)

The event transitioned to Ohrid, where Workshop 3 concentrated on online courses, quizzes, and utilizing the Moodle test platform. Additionally, Workshop 4 introduced participants to open-source software for multimedia creation, focusing on video lectures, image, and PDF editing. The day concluded with a cultural visit to Saint Naum Church and a delightful boat trip.

## Day 5: Collaborative Tools and Closing Ceremony (Ohrid)

Participants engaged in Workshop 5, which emphasized using online tools for student collaboration. This was followed by a closing ceremony, during which certificates were awarded to participants. Valuable feedback was gathered to improve future iterations of the workshop.

## **I. Welcome Speech - Project Coordinator (Monika Jaworska)**

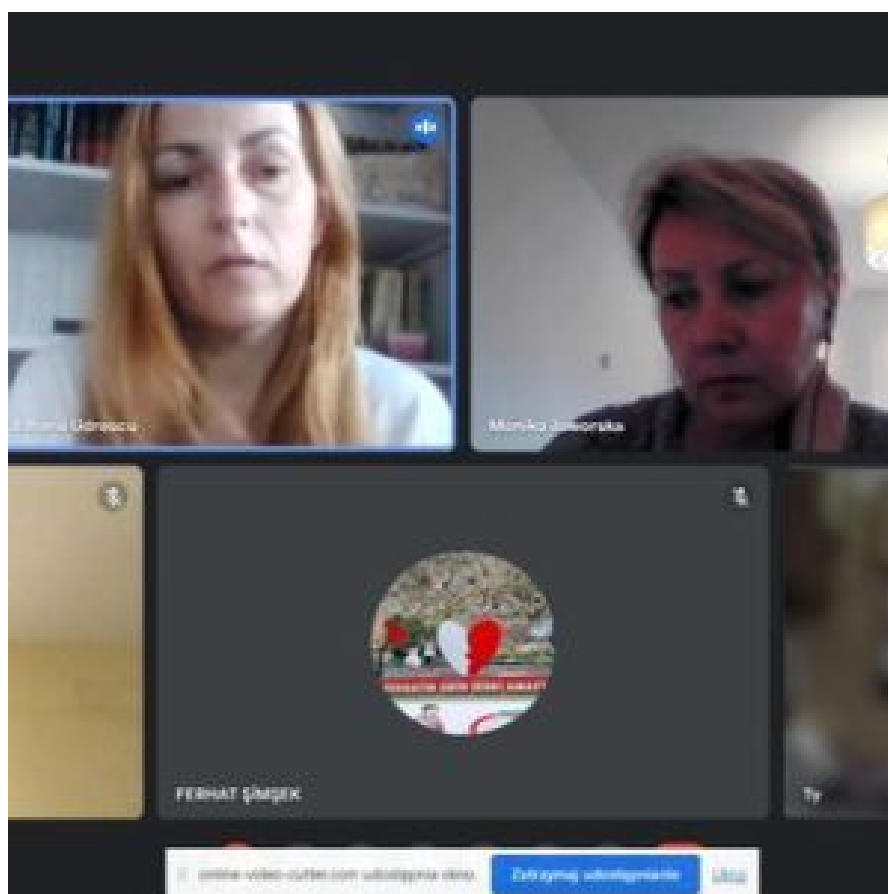
The meeting began with a warm welcome from Monika Jaworska, the Project Coordinator. She expressed her gratitude to all participants for their continued commitment and participation in the project.

# FCL LEARNING SCENARIOS

A template was made by Romanian partner to create FCL learning scenarios. According to that template, each partner created 3 learning scenarios.

Bulgarian partner's topics are "Global Citizens", "What the World Eats " and "World Breakfast".

Italy worked on "Mediterranean Diet", "Sfincione is not pizza!" and "Sightseeing around Bagheria".

North Macedonia created scenarios about "Java programming", "Graphic design" and "Topography (calculation of distance and azimuth)".

Poland planned scenarios about different things like taking a virtual trip to London, understanding how to stay healthy, and celebrating Thanksgiving. In Romania, students found out about the layers of the Earth, the Pythagoras theorem in math, and how functions work.

In Turkey, students got to know their traditions, enjoyed music, and learned about how things look and what makes them special.
